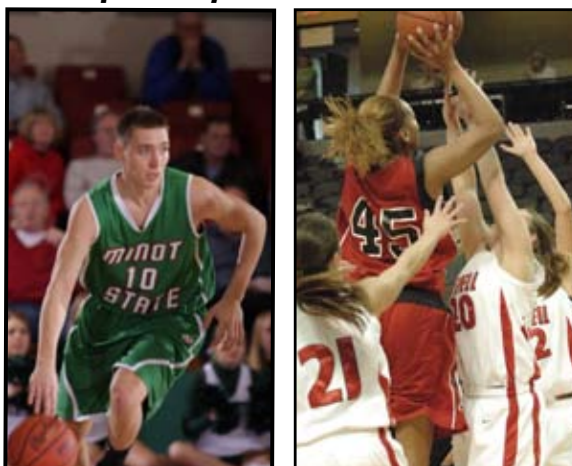

SUMMER 2009 MSU ATHLETIC CAMPS

Boys & Girls Mini-Camp: Registration 8:00 A.M. to 9 A.M., Monday, July 20. Daily Schedule 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. for grades K – 2, & 9 A.M. to 4 P.M. for grades 3 – 6. All campers receive a free basketball & t-shirt. Grades 3 – 6 also receive their noon meal. Camp concludes on Thursday, July 23 at 12 P.M. for grades K – 2 & at 4 P.M. for grades 3 – 6.

Boys Individual Basketball Camp: Registration 5 to 6 P.M., Sunday, June 21, followed by camp from 6:30 to 9 P.M. Daily schedule 8:30 A.M. to 9 P.M. All campers receive a basketball & t-shirt. Camp concludes with an awards presentation at 12 P.M., Thursday, June 25. No lunch provided on the last day for those on a meal plan.

Boys & Girls Individual Instruction: Times to be arranged with Men's Basketball Head Coach, Mike Hultz. Participants will receive one hour of private instruction each day. Focus will be on shooting, ball handling and individual moves.

Girls Individual Basketball Camp: Registration 5 to 6 P.M., Sunday, June 7, followed by camp from 6:30 to 9 P.M. Daily schedule 8:30 A.M. to 9 P.M. All campers receive a basketball & t-shirt. Camp concludes with an awards presentation at 12 P.M., Thursday, June 11. No lunch provided on the last day for those on a meal plan.

Volleyball Skills Camp: Registration 8 to 9 A.M., Monday, June 15. Full days run from 9 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. All campers receive a free t-shirt. Camp concludes with an awards presentation at 3 P.M. on Wednesday, June 17.

Volleyball Team Camp: runs from 9 A.M. to 8 P.M., Thursday, June 18, & 9 A.M. to 5 P.M., Friday, June 19. Six team limit.

Football Camp (Grades 7 – 12):

Entry deadline for all football camps is July 24. Each camper receives lunch & a t-shirt. Final registration 8 A.M. - 9 A.M. Camps run from 9 A.M. to 4:30 P.M.

Linebackers & Defensive Backs Camp—Mon. July 27. All players supply their own helmet, shoulder pads & football shoes.

Offensive & Defensive Line Camp—Tues. July 28. All players supply their own helmet, shoulder pads & football shoes.

Quarterbacks & Runningbacks & Wide Receivers Camp—Wed. July 29. Quarterbacks should bring their own football.

CAMP SPECIAL FEATURES: Camp t-shirt, participation certificate, achievement awards, thorough instruction, daily instructional clinics, guest speakers and demonstrations, daily competitions, outstanding coaching staff, individual attention, highly organized instruction, and evaluation on fundamentals with lots of personal attention.

CAMP DEPOSIT AND PRE-REGISTRATION: A minimum \$25.00 deposit must accompany this application, with the balance due at registration. (You can pay in full if you choose.) Please make checks payable to MSU. CAMP FEES are listed on the registration form.

DISCOUNTS: If five or more players from the same town enroll at the same time, each player will receive a discount of \$10 off the registration fee. (To receive discounts, ALL registrations MUST be sent in the same envelope.) If two or more from the same family attend the same camp, both players will receive a discount of \$10 off the registration fee. If one player attends two camps they can receive a \$10 discount on the second camp (except on team camp). No discounts will be allowed for the K – 2 mini-camp or the football camps.

RESIDENT CAMPERS: You will need to bring bed linens (twin bed) or sleeping bag, pillow, alarm clock, and your workout gear and necessities. No evening meal will be provided on the first night of the basketball camps and the breakfast meal will not be provided on the first day of volleyball camp. You may choose your roommate at time of check-in.

KEY DEPOSIT: A key deposit of \$10 is required at the time of check-in. This deposit will be refunded at the conclusion of camp upon return of the key.
